OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance. The remaining 1.5 mills is only available to be levied to restore millage lost as a result of any reduction of millage that may be required by the "Headlee" amendment to the Michigan Constitution of 1963, as amended, and will only be levied to the extent necessary to restore that reduction.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Bear Lake Schools, Manistee County, Michigan, be increased by 19.50 mills (\$19.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 3 years, 2011, 2012 and 2013, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2011 is approximately \$877,343 (this is a renewal of millage which expired with the 2010 tax levy)?

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Manistee Area Public Schools, Manistee and Mason Counties, Michigan, be increased by 18 mills (\$18.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 5 years, 2011 to 2015, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2011 is approximately \$4,230,389 (this is a renewal of millage which expired with the 2010 tax levy)?

SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE PROPOSAL (RESTORATION OF HEADLEE REDUCTION)

This proposal requests additional millage to permit the continued levy by the intermediate school district of the maximum mills for special education previously approved by the electors.

Shall the current charter limitation on the annual property tax rate for the education of students with a disability in Manistee Intermediate School District, Michigan, be increased by .2104 mill (\$.2104 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a period of 5 years, 2011 to 2015, inclusive (this increase will allow the intermediate school district to levy the maximum rate of 2 mills previously approved by the electors which has been reduced as required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963); the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2011 is approximately \$226,082 from local property taxes authorized herein?

Shall Maple Grove Township, Manistee County, Michigan renew the expired previous voted increases in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution of two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) be renewed at the original voted two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) and levied for four (4) years, 2011 through 2014 inclusive, for the purpose of Fire Department protection, maintenance, equipment and education (training)? If approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year the millage is levied would be \$68,227.

PROPOSITION 2: TRANSFER STATION RENEWAL

Shall Maple Grove Township, Manistee County, Michigan renew the expired previous voted increases in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution of two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) be renewed at the original voted two (2) mills (\$2.00 per \$1,000.00 of

taxable value) and levied for four (4) years, 2011 through 2014 inclusive, for the purpose of operating the Township garbage and refuse transfer station? If approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year the millage is levied would be \$68,227.

PROPOSITION 3: CEMETARY RENEWAL

Shall Maple Grove Township, Manistee County, Michigan renew the expired previous voted increases in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution of one-half (0.50) mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value), which was reduced to 0.4978 mills by the required millage rollback, be increased to and renewed at the original voted one-half (0.50) mills (\$0.50 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) and levied for four (4) years, 2011 through 2014 inclusive, for the operating purpose of cemetery upkeep and maintenance? If approved, it is estimated that the revenue generated by this proposal in the first year the millage is levied would be \$17,057.
