During a meeting with the Manistee County Commissioner's "Green Team" in August Manistee Manufacturers Council (MMC) members indicated that they believed emissions information was available to the public via the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) website. Subsequent to that discussion MMC members have learned that although the State of Michigan maintains interactive capability with regard to required data submissions, they do not at the present time have similar capability for the public to view the same data.

It remains the practice of our members to provide the required data regarding emissions to the MDEQ, and to let that agency disseminate it appropriately. Inquiries from groups or individuals who are interested in that information should be made to the MDEQ's District office in Cadillac, (231) 775-3960, or for specific questions pertaining to emissions to surface waters they may contact the Water Resources Division, District Manager Mr. Brian Jankowski (231) 876-4474.

Although the MMC was unable to provide Manistee County Green Team members with the simplified access we had hoped would be available, we remain committed to being accessible to discuss any specific concerns or questions that may arise. Please do not hesitate to contact us should there be future needs for information regarding our operations or emissions.
