# APPENDIX A

The City of Petoskey has provided the Petoskey District Library with six Kill A Watt electricity usage monitors that are available to library card holders who are concerned about the amount of energy they are using. These monitors measure how much electricity your electric appliances and devices – such as refrigerators, microwaves, computers, TVs, phone chargers, game consoles and cable boxes – are consuming when plugged in. The large LCD display will count consumption by the kilowatt-hour. Kill A Watt monitors can also be used to measure the amount of energy an electronic device will draw, even when turned off and in standby mode.

- Kill A Watt electricity usage monitors model P4400 from P3 International (cost on Amazon is about \$20)
- They check out for a 3 week period
- They've gone out 21 times since July 25
- 1 available for check-out at each of MCL's 6 locations would be an easy way to get this resource out into the community
